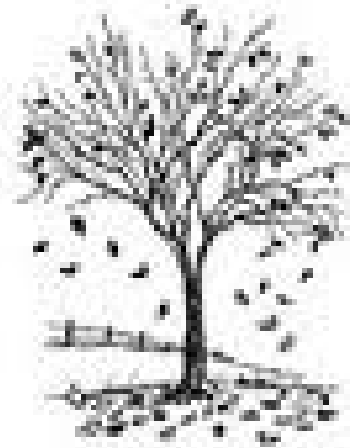




Trouble Tree
