Ash Wednesday

Ash Wednesday is this week on 13th February. It is a day of both fast and abstinence. Fasting – having only one meal and two small meals – is obligatory for those aged between eighteen and sixty, with the exception of those who are ill or have a medical condition. Abstinence, which means abstaining from meat, is obligatory for all those who are over fourteen years of age. The Masses on Ash Wednesday will be in the Sacred Heart Church at 8 am, 10 am and 7.30 pm. Ashes will be distributed after all Masses on Wednesday.


