Fr Noel is a native of Bandon, County Cork and was ordained to the priesthood in 1976. An alumnus of Saint Patrick's College, Maynooth, he also completed doctoral studies at the Institut Catholique de Paris. His vast ministerial experience includes service as a parish priest, a secondary school principal and a university lecturer. In addition to his current role as Lecturer of Systematic Theology at the Pontifical University, Maynooth, Fr Noel also serves as Dean of the Diocese of Cork & Ross. We look forward to welcoming Fr Noel amongst us and to be renewed by the insights he will share on how we might fully realise our call to be missionary disciples at the heart of our parish community.

**Coffee Morning**

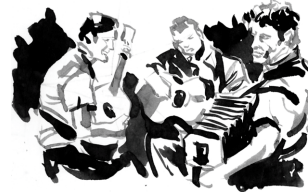
