



Eucharistic Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

Eucharistic Adoration is when a host, consecrated into the body of Christ during the Mass, is placed in a monstrance. The monstrance is then placed on the altar for adoration. During adoration you can have some time alone with Jesus to recite your favourite prayers of thanksgiving, petition and reparation. You may wish to read the bible or pray a novena or rosary before Our Lord. You can just sit and say nothing, simply keeping Him company, just as you would with a dear friend. When you look upon the Sacred Host, you look upon Jesus, the Son of God. *"Indeed, this is the will of my Father that everyone who looks upon the Son and believes in Him shall have eternal life and will be raised up on the last day."* Jn 6:40



Pope John Paul II encouraged Eucharistic Adoration: "The Church and the world have a great need of Eucharistic adoration. This is a personal invitation to you from Jesus. Jesus waits for us in this sacrament of love. Let us be generous with our time in going to meet Jesus and ready to make reparation for the great evils of the world. Let your adoration never cease." (Pope John Paul II, Dominicae Cenae). Pope Francis also advocates Eucharistic Adoration as often as possible.
