Monday 1st September is our next parish day for Marriage and Family Life.

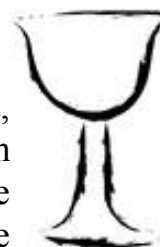
"Knock and the door will be opened to you"

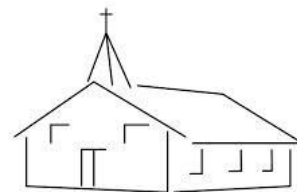
