A few words from Fr Joseph

Dear Parishioners, most of you will have heard by now your new curate's name is Fr Joseph Varghese. I was ordained 27 years ago (31st December1997) for the Syro-Malabar Archdiocese of Changanacherry in Kerala, India. After nine years serving in different capacities in my native Archdiocese, I was sent to England (2006) to study in the University of London to secure a Master's degree. In 2010 I was invited to the Diocese of Derry for the first time and served as a curate in St Eugene's Cathedral and Long Tower Parish and then was transferred to Waterside St Columba's for 4 years. Bishop Donal appointed me as a curate in Dungiven in 2016 and I have been there since. During my time in Dungiven I achieved a doctorate in Theology (Christology) from Maynooth University. I hope to use this study in helping to promote Pope Francis' wishes now towards new evangelization. I had a quite busy time in Dungiven with Masses, Baptisms, Weddings, Funerals and working in Schools but on talking with Fr Eugene I feel that I will have a busier time here in Drumragh Parish. I am very willing to take up this challenge. I really looking forward to meeting and getting to know you all. Parishioners, please pray for Fr Eugene and myself that together with you we will do our utmost to fulfil Pope Francis' wishes and that may God bless our efforts.

The theme for Season of Creation 2024 is "To Hope and Act with Creation." (cf Rom 8:22). In the letter of Saint Paul to the Romans, we see the biblical image of the Earth groaning. Today we hear the cry of the Earth all around us. The times in which we live show that we are not relating to the Earth as a gift from our Creator, but rather as a resource to be used. And yet, there is hope and the expectation for a better future. To hope in a biblical context does not mean to stand still and quiet but, rather, to actively strive for new life amidst the struggles. The Season of Creation has a special significance for the Catholic Church, particularly since Pope Francis established 1 September as an annual World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. The Season of Creation is marked throughout the Christian world from 1st September to 4th October (Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi) and celebrates the joy of creation as well as encouraging awareness-raising initiatives to protect the natural environment.
