Overview of the Gospel

This passage is part of Jesus' Sermon on the Plain in Luke's Gospel. Here, Jesus uses three vivid images to illustrate the importance of integrity, humility, and selfawareness:

- The blind leading the blind A warning that we cannot guide others if we are spiritually blind ourselves.
- The plank and the splinter A reminder to examine our own faults before pointing out the faults of others.

A tree and its fruit – A person's words and actions reveal what is truly in their heart. Jesus calls us to self-reflection before judging others. If we wish to lead others closer to God, we must first ensure that our own hearts are rooted in goodness.


