The Annual Parish Memorial for those who have died throughout the year will take place at the **7.30pm evening Mass on Monday 4th November**. As a Parish Community we will remember all who have died or were laid to rest in our Parish between 1st October **2023 and the 30th September 2024.** The names of the deceased will be read out and a candle lit for each one in their memory. We offer our prayerful solidarity and support to the bereaved and invite you to join us for Mass on this evening.

A Book of Remembrance will be available for you to enter the names of your beloved who have died elsewhere. They will be prayed for at daily Mass throughout the month of November.

Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls

From 12 noon on 1st November until 12am on 2nd November all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1st November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1st to 8th November. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.

Deceased Children & Young People's Mass: The Annual Mass for deceased children and young people will take place in St Eugene's Cathedral, Derry, next Sunday, 10th November, at 7:00pm. There will be an opportunity to write down the name of your deceased loved one before Mass. All are welcome to attend. You can also join this Mass live on the St Eugene's Cathedral webcam.
