When we are seeking attention for ourselves, we are pushing God out of the picture. When we measure our deeds by size, by the acclaim they get, we are neither acting for God nor for others: we are being self-centred. And we devalue others if we measure their work by the attention they get. Is life all about attention and acclaim? It's surely a pity if it is. God doesn't see it that way.

It could be helping someone in need, offering time to someone who is lonely, or donating to a cause you believe in. Let this action be a quiet expression of your faith, done solely out of love and service to God.


