

Brief Overview of today's Gospel

The rich man's attachment to his possessions prevents him from responding to Jesus' call to discipleship. Jesus emphasises the difficulty for the wealthy to enter God's Kingdom, not because wealth itself is evil, but because it can become a barrier to entering wholehearted into living life as God asks. We never fully enter into life, we never become fully who we are born to be if we are focused on money or possessions. Following Jesus doesn't happen without detachment, or without the faith perspective on what true life and living are about.

How can we be more generous with our time, talent, and resources for the sake of others, especially those in need?

The Cost of Discipleship: Reflect on Jesus' call to follow Him wholeheartedly. Allow God's appreciation to strike home with you for your willingness to let go of something for his sake or the sake of others. At this time, might there be some attachment that shows you less willing to embrace his call? Pray for patience with yourself if you feel disappointed and pray for the courage to make sacrifices and grow deeper in your relationship with Christ.

This week, take time to identify one way you can practice greater generosity, whether by giving to those in need, offering time to someone who is lonely, or detaching from something that distracts you from God. Let this be a concrete step toward living out Jesus' call to follow Him more fully.
