Reflections:

Jesus' call to take up the cross and follow Him flatly confronts modern-day ideas of the 'good life'. The modern culture prizes achievement, consumption, property, and possessions and sees them as signs of success. But for Jesus, success is being faithful even when life brings—or even requires—us to suffer. Think marriage. Think priesthood. Think educators and healthcare workers. There is no walk of life that is dedicated to caring for others that does not, from time to time, involve suffering. Also think illness. Being faithful to God's gift of life, when death and unavoidable illness come: these too are a taking up of the cross. All these things do something to us inwardly. They form virtues and values in us that are already the life of heaven growing in us. Today's society frequently promotes the pursuit of personal gain and self-preservation as the highest goals. Jesus' message is countercultural, urging us to find life not through accumulation or self-promotion, but through self-denial and service to others. This Gospel challenges us to reflect on what we are willing to sacrifice for the sake of Christ and His Gospel, reminding us that true fulfilment (true personal growth, true humanity) comes from living a life oriented towards God and others.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, You call us to follow You on the path of the cross. Grant us the courage to deny ourselves, take up our cross, and follow You, trusting that in losing our life for Your sake, we will find it. Help us to live as true disciples, embracing the challenges of this life with faith and hope in Your promise of eternal life. Amen.
