Connecting the Gospel to Today's Context

Jesus uses startling words to challenge conventional values. It's strange to hear him say that being rich, having our fill of food and entertainment, is the road to disaster. How could that be! He's telling us that we are more likely to 'lose ourselves' and 'lose God' when we focus on such things. But the key issue is that we are also more likely to overlook those who live in crisis. To stay close to them is to stay close to God. The truest happiness comes from trusting in God and caring for those in need, not from pursuing wealth or personal comfort. Ultimately, the message is that adopting a godly perspective—one that values selflessness and service over self-centred fulfilment—leads to a richer, more meaningful life.

The Gospel reverses worldly values, calls us to a deeper discipleship, promises that God will put things right in heaven and puts social justice in pride of place.

The Gospel recalls the place of what the Catholic tradition calls "The Corporal Works of Mercy", namely: to give sustenance to the hungry and to the thirsty; to clothe those who need clothes; to aid those who need shelter; to visit those sick or imprisoned and to honour the dead with proper burial. Doing these things grows the spirit and character in us that God calls us to: they make us better citizens and better people.
