

#### **Important Update on Sacred Heart Church Restoration Project**

We wish to inform you of an important update regarding the timeline for our Sacred Heart Church Restoration Project with the Heritage Fund. Initially, we planned to submit our Round 2 application by November 15th of this year, with the anticipation of commencing capital restoration works in April/May 2025. However, following advice from the Heritage Fund, we will now be delaying our submission until the end of February 2025. Consequently, a decision on funding will not be received until May 2025, which means that the commencement of capital restoration works would be rescheduled to begin around August/September 2025. While this adjustment may seem like a setback, it also presents an unforeseen opportunity. A recent architectural survey has uncovered the need for urgent repairs around the underside of the Rose Window at the front of the building. This additional time allows us the possibility to include these crucial repair works in our Round 2 submission to the Heritage Fund.

We appreciate your understanding and continued support as we navigate these changes. This adjustment not only ensures that we address all necessary repairs to preserve the integrity of our beloved church but also aligns our efforts more closely with the requirements and timing of the Heritage Fund.

Thank you for your patience and dedication to the restoration of Sacred Heart Church. We will keep you informed of any further developments. Fr. Eugene Hasson PP
