

Reflections

Was there a moment in the last few days where I served another person without seeking recognition? Take a moment to look back at that moment and appreciate that you were following Jesus in "giving without counting the cost'. Might that have been a moment recently where I felt 'taken for granted'? Was there anything in me caused me to be dissatisfied in that moment? Can I name what that was now and bring it to God in prayer? Is there anything in my mentality there that I or God would want to see changed? Pray about that too.

Children are trusting and need to be loved. When hurts come, those children can close up and being to rely on other forms of satisfaction? Is there any element of that in me? Did I notice myself being closed to someone else recently? Is there something in my behaviour that might point to a past hurt that debilitates our willingness to connect in the present? Imagine yourself as the child that Jesus is clasping. How are you reacting? What might you learn from that? Is there room for me to foster a more trusting and receptive spirit in my relationship with God? How do I define success in my life? Am I willing to let go of worldly measures of greatness and embrace the path of service to others? What things in my life can I point to as evidence of my worldly ambition? What things can I point to in my life as evidence that my worldly ambition is getting less (even to a small amount)?

This week, take time to perform a simple act of service for someone who may not be able to repay you. Reflect on how this brings you closer to the heart of Jesus and His example of humility.

Prayer:

Lord Jesus, You came not to be served but to serve. Teach us the true meaning of greatness, that we may be humble and willing to serve others as You did. Help us to welcome the vulnerable and embrace the path of self-giving love, trusting in Your promise of life eternal. Amen.
