Word of God Sunday.

The Third Sunday of Ordinary Time is the 'Sunday of the Word of God' - a day, instituted by Pope Francis on the Feast of Saint Jerome in 2019, devoted to the celebration and study of Sacred Scripture.

Word of God Sunday is a celebration that invites Catholics to renew their relationship with the Bible and to listen attentively to the living Word of God that speaks to the Church and the world. It serves as a reminder of the foundational role of Scripture in Christian life and the ongoing relevance of God's message. Although primarily a Catholic observance, its focus on the Bible resonates across the many Christian traditions. Pope Francis' intention (in introducing this new observance in 2020) was also to foster unity among Christians by promoting a sharing in the respect for the Scriptures and in encouraging participation in a deeper dialogue and reflection on God's Word across denominations. Word of God Sunday is a call to hear God's Word as something living and fresh. The Bible may have been composed in the past, but it continues to speak today. Through it, God speaks directly to the faithful.

We are called to allow it to shape our lives.
