Church Unity

A week of prayer for Christian Unity takes place from 18th to 25th January 2012. The theme this year is **"We will all be changed by the Victory of our Lord Jesus Christ"** (cf. 1 Cor 15:51-58). The Ecumenical Service for the Week of Prayer comes to us from Poland where an ecumenical group has written a liturgy that draws on the experience of Polish Christians who have lived through times of joy and adversity. The history of Poland has been marked by a series of defeats, victories, invasions, partitions and oppression by foreign powers and hostile systems. The constant striving to overcome all enslavement and the desire for freedom are a feature of Polish history. As we pray for and strive towards the full visible unity of the church we - and the traditions to which we belong - will be changed, transformed and conformed to the likeness of Christ. We need to open ourselves to each other, to offer gifts to and receive gifts from one another, so that we might truly enter into the new life in Christ, which is the only true victory.



The Annual Church Unity Service will take place this year in St Mary's Church, Killyclogher at 7 pm on Sunday 22nd January, followed by light refreshments in Cappagh Parish Centre. The Service is open to all denominations. All are welcome to attend. If anyone wants to sing in the choir at this week's Ecumenical Service in St Mary's Killyclogher, please come to the organ gallery at 6.30 pm.

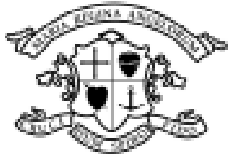

What is a Deacon?**

The word 'Deacon' comes
from the Greek word 'diakonia' which means
'service'. The work of the deacon is an act of
service to the community. Deacons can read
the Gospel, preach the homily, baptise and
perform other ceremonies where there is no
Mass. There are two types of deacon who
minister in the Church. The first is someone
who is training to be a priest and this is the last
step before finally being ordained a priest. The
second is called a Permanent Deacon and he is
not going to be ordained a priest. We know
that priests cannot get married but a married
man can be ordained a Permanent Deacon. At
the moment we have very few Permanent
Deacons in our country. But this may change
in the next few years.
